

SUGGESTED 3% EXTRA CREDIT ASSIGNMENTS

**BSAD 8010 Legal, Ethical, and Social Environment  
Fall 2004**

To the eyes of the instructor, all negotiated Extra Credit assignments must require from the student no less than **12 clock hours** of effort beyond that required for the course itself.

All Extra Credit assignments shall be reported using the **Poster Session format** (see Syllabus G8 assignment).

Suggested items include, but are not limited to:

- [1] **Forecast the Federal Funds Rate** for the next three meetings of the FOMC using a minimum of four and a maximum of eight relevant variables, with the historical duration of each variable with a minimum of four and a maximum of twenty years of observations.
- [2] Evaluate a building for its **Green Building Rating** for either Silver or LEED:
  - [a] your BCA firm,
  - [b] your employer, or
  - [c] a UNO building.
- [3] **Sustainability appraisal** of:
  - [a] your BCA firm, or
  - [b] your employer.
- [4] Interview a **statutory insider** of
  - [a] your BCA firm, or
  - [b] your employer.
- [5] Use of **animals** in entertainment, medical research, or food.
- [6] Vulnerability analysis of the **ADR policy** of:
  - [a] your BCA firm, or
  - [b] your employer.
- [7] Interview "your" attorney at your place of employment on both **your status as "client"** and the attorney's **dispute resolution strategy** for your position
- [8] **Book report** on a book that is in the UNO library, has more than 200 pages, and is on the topic of the **sustainability of the industry** of:
  - [a] your BCA firm, or
  - [b] your employer.
- [9] A **cradle-to-cradle analysis** of a consumer good you personally consume.
- [10] Present student paper at the **Nebraska Economics and Business Association** meeting.
